


GLAZING PLANS











Roof 6x8

BEFORE YOU START

- This task is accomplished more easily with two people.
- Gloves and goggles are recommended. No tools are required.
- Identify all glass panels.
- Locate the Z-clips, supplied separately.
- Locate the W-clips from the greenhouse pack.

USING THE W-CLIPS TO SECURE THE GLAZING

- The glazing is fixed with wire spring clips, also known as W-clips because of their shape.
- Once the glazing is in place, secure it with the W-clips as shown in the photograph.
- Use three W-clips to each side of the largest panels and two for smaller panels.
- The small panel in the middle of the door requires only one W-clip each side.
- The W-clips should be a tight fit so a little pressure may be required to fix them in place.
- The appearance will be neater if the W-clips are evenly spaced and symmetrical.



USING THE Z-CLIPS TO OVERLAP THE GLAZING

- Two Z-clips are required between the higher and lower glazing at the front and rear.
- First, slot the Z-clips over the top of the lower glazing panels.
- Next, the higher glazing panels can be lowered onto the Z-clips.
- Once the glass panels are in place, secure them with W-clips

GLAZING THE ROOF VENT

- The roof vent should be glazed during installation.
- For further details please refer to the separate greenhouse erection instructions.
